- 1) ENTRIES TAKEN ON THE DAY FROM 11.00AM
- 2) Judging : starts 12.00 pm - Novelty classes follow Pedigree BIS
- 3) Trophies : Pedigree BIS, RBIS and PBIS, Novelty BIS
- 4) Rosettes : 1st to 6th place in each class
- 5) Pedigree classes judge : Mrs J Barr (Megabyte - Staffies)
- 6) Novelty classes judge : Morag Sutherland
- 7) Only dogs 6 months and over on Show Day are eligible for entry.
- 8) More pedigree class only eligibility rules appear at page foot.

Dog Show class details appear below, split into pedigree and novelty classes open to all dogs.
